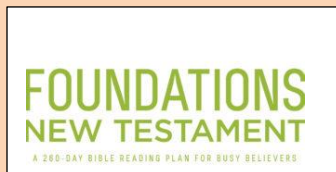

HEALTH NEWS:

"New Screening Recommendations for Cervical Cancer"

In the past, cervical cancer was one of the most common cancer killers of American women. It is still diagnosed in 13,000 American women a year and will kill more than 4,000 of them, according to the American Cancer Society. "Most cases of cervical cancer occur among women who have not been adequately screened. Cervical cancer generally takes 19 to 20 years to develop, making annual testing an unnecessary medical procedure for most women. The current guidelines are as follows: All women should begin cervical cancer screening at age 21. Women between the ages of 21 and 29 should have a Pap test every 3 years. Therefore, it is important that you establish care with you doctor at age 21 so that a plan for routine screening can be determined.
