HEALTH ARTICLE: SIGNS OF BULLYING

- *Unexplained injuries that cannot be explained.
- *Watch for lost and damaged items.
- *Exaggerated hunger caused by avoiding lunch or sudden binge eating or skipping meals.
- *Fake sickness to avoid riding the bus or going to school.
- *Loss of interest in schoolwork with declining grades.
- *Changes in sleeping patterns or sudden onset of nightmares or bedwetting.
- *Develop bullying behaviors, sudden aggressive or unwanted behavior towards younger siblings mimicking what is happening to them.
- *Show signs of self-destructive behavior such as hurting themselves physically, drinking, drugs, and isolation.
